Andrew Haydon Park is located on the Ottawa River and is managed by the City of Ottawa, Ottawa, Ontario, Canada. It is situated north off Carling Avenue at Holly Acres Road.

Facilities include a bandshell for outdoor concerts and a picnic area. The Nepean Sailing Club is located nearby at the adjacent Dick Bell Park. The park features walking trails, play structures, and picnicking.

Migrating Canada Geese, brants, ducks, and shorebirds stop over along the marshy edges of the river near the park. Resident Canada geese and mallards also inhabit the park's two ponds.

The park was named after Andrew Haydon, former Reeve of Nepean.

The landscape-architect Donald W. Graham worked on this project.
